I hope you and your families are well and that you are enjoying summer vacation. Below I have outlined our current plan for opening school on September 1. This fall our staff will deliver an engaging, rigorous distance learning plan that follows a daily schedule and includes live instruction. The Pendleton High School staff is committed to delivering a high quality instructional model that will look very different from distance learning last spring.

Comprehensive Distance Learning Plan Pendleton High School

Distance Learning Logistics

- Students are required to participate in live class instruction Monday-Friday. This approach aligns with best instructional practices and state guidance.
- Distance learning will be operating synchronously with students in their current class schedules in a virtual classroom setting.
- All teachers will use a Google Classroom platform.
- Classes will be instructed live, in a Google Meeting platform, at scheduled times every day (see Gold/Green schedules)
- Live instruction will be recorded and uploaded daily allowing students to access lessons for additional support or in case of absence.
- Teachers will take attendance and give grades every period. For example, the grade for a class period could be student participation, an exit ticket, or an assignment. A daily grade represents attendance that day.
- Four classes will be taught each day, rotating on a Gold/Green schedule.
- Advisory will be held 8th period. This is a time for teachers to check-in with students and for students to participate in interactive lessons supporting Social Emotional Learning and other topics.
- Registration will take place within the next two weeks via phone call or on-line.
- Chromebook and textbook check-out is scheduled September 1-4 in a drive-through format.
- Classes start Tuesday, September 8.
