<u>Swim Instructor/Lifeguard</u> - Requirements same as above plus must have Water Safety Instructor certification. Must be at least 16 years of age. Wage range - \$13.70-\$14.70 per hr.

<u>Swim Instructor Aide</u> - Position requires: Current Red Cross Lifeguard Training, Standard First Aid, AED, CPR for the Professional Rescuer, or equivalent training as recognized by the American Red Cross or State. Must be at least 14 years of age. Wage \$13.70-\$14.45 per hr.

<u>Admission/Concession Attendant</u> - Provide customer service at Aquatic Center admission desk or in food court. Must be 15 years of age at time of employment; have current food handler card; and possess good public service skills. Wage range - \$13.70-\$14.20 per hr.
